• Do you have a yard, street or neighborhood concern you think needs to be resolved, but you are just not sure how to start? We have added a section to the Bridlespur Homeowners Association website providing a process to deal with common code concerns. This includes a link to all of the codes enforced by the City with links to the most common for ease of use.

- The process for investigating, reporting, and asking for support is just a few clicks away. 1.) Go to Welcome Home and 2.) click on "Site Navigation" then select 3.) "Issue Reporting Process".
 - There you can find the links to common concerns and the city codes covering them. There is also a detailed process for getting help with your concern once you have looked at the code. Even if you don't need to research a problem, use the page for how to report a problem.
- Remember, talking to someone about a concern with empathy and respect is usually the best place to start. This process was recently updated with input from our City Code representative to make sure we have the process down right. Hopefully this helps Neighbors find the resources they need to understand and resolve concerns they see in the neighborhood. It takes all of us to support a vibrant and comfortable community!
