- Bins will be 65 gallons and have the ability to hold up to five trash bags. The two bag limit will no longer be applicable.
- Trash should still be placed in bags prior to being put in bins.
- Trash bins will have gray lids to easily tell them apart from recycling bins with yellow lids.
